

Combination of rooms

The Auditorium can be rented in combination with a small meeting room, for break-out sessions, for example. In combination with the use of the Auditorium, you will receive a 20% discount on the rental price per half day for each additional small room booked.



Auditorium

The Auditorium of H'ART Museum is a special multifunctional space suitable for presentations, lectures and conferences. Receptions, walking dinners, seated dinners, drinks and parties are also possible here.

The Auditorium seats up to 400* people and is located in the Garden Wing of the museum, above the Foyer and the Grand Café. The Auditorium has a full-range sound system that can be used both lengthwise and crosswise. A lectern with a microphone on the stage and possibly a wireless hand-held microphone make it possible to present without hiring additional technical facilities. A laptop computer can be connected to the beamer via HDMI at the front and back of the Auditorium.

The Auditorium can also be rented in combination with the small meeting rooms, for break-out sessions, for example.

The Auditorium is available per half day from 8 a.m.



Meeting rooms

The three meeting rooms; London room, Paris room, Washington D.C. room, located next to the Auditorium, can be rented together with the Auditorium. Suitable for small presentations, lectures and courses. The meeting rooms are available by the day from 8 a.m.

Paris room



Washington D.C. room


- The room can be used by up to 50 people

- Flexible space suitable for different types of events





H'ART Museum Grand Café

H'ART Museum Grand Café, located on the first floor, is a wonderful place where you can enjoy a home-made lunch or a delicious drink during the day before, during or after a visit to the museum.

The Grand Café also supports all culinary activities for your business meeting or event. This atmospheric place is also available for private receptions, during the day but also in the evening. A unique place in Amsterdam where you can enjoy a delicious dinner or festive drinks with larger groups.







Church Hall

The most beautiful location on the Amstel, the Church Hall can be used for your reception, walking dinner or seated dinner. The Church Hall is available after opening hours of the museum after approval of the management.





Regents & Regency

The Regents room and the Regency room are available for an elegant, small and intimate dinner or a lavishly decorated reception for up to 40 guests in one of the most beautiful dining rooms in Amsterdam. The Regents room has beautiful views of the Amstel River and Nieuwe Herengracht, while the Regency room faces the Amstel and Nieuwe Prinsengracht.

The Protestant community provided money so that the Amstelhof could be set up. This was initially only an old women's home but later also opened to men. The women and men had to be strictly be separated in the beginning. The men

stayed in the Amsterdam wing and the regents (who took care of the men's side and therefore, also took care of the financial part of that wing) were in the Regents room.



Courtyard

During the day, an oasis of calmness, as well as a place to stay for visitors, but outside opening hours, available on request for your event in combination with use of the rooms of H'ART Museum. The courtyard is ideal for receptions for large groups, from packed lunches to chic dinners. The design of the garden is by Michael van Gessel. The three old chestnut trees are joined by four newly planted wingnut trees.

Limited paid parking is available in the immediate vicinity. The nearest guarded parking lots are those of the Nationale Opera & Ballet, The Bank in Amstelstraat, Parking Waterlooplein on Valkenburgerstraat and Markenhoven near the entrance to the IJtunnel.

Public Transportation

Tram 4, stop Rembrandtplein and lines 9 and 14, stop Waterlooplein Metro 51, 53 and 54, stop Waterlooplein, exit at Nieuwe Herengracht.
